## I, David M. Lind MD declare as follows:

- The facts that I state are based on my thirty-eight years of practice as an OBGYN, my experience and my review of literature.
- I submit this affidavit in support of the Life is a Human Right Act, a law that
  makes it illegal to provide elective abortions while still allowing medically
  necessary abortion services.

## 3. My background.

- a. I am a lifelong resident of Cheyenne, born in the hospital where I practiced OBGYN for nearly 35 years. I received my Bachelors and Master's degrees in Zoology and Physiology from the University of Wyoming. I was accepted at Creighton University School of Medicine under the Wyoming contracts program and graduated in 1982. I completed the University of Wyoming Family Medicine Residency Program at Cheyenne in 1985 then completed a residency at Good Samaritan Medical Center in Phoenix, AZ in 1988. I joined Cheyenne Obstetrics and Gynecology, PC and practiced until I retired in January 2022. Since that time, I have provided Locums Tenens services to other Wyoming hospitals.
- b. I provided obstetrical and gynecologic care, managed high risk pregnancies, provided obstetrical and gynecologic services as well as emergency care and surgery. I have delivered more than 7500 babies in my career.

- 4. The Life is a Human Right Act provides the unborn with the rights and dignity of all humans. It recognizes that unborn babies are individuals endowed by our creator with unalienable rights, particularly life.
- The Life is a Human Right Act defines the situations that require medical treatment such as miscarriages and ectopic pregnancies and other conditions that will not result in a live human being.
- 6. This law provides for the rare circumstances in which an abortion is necessary to preserve the life of the mother.
- 7. This law also allows for termination of a pregnancy with a lethal anomaly, a condition in which the baby will not be able to survive outside the womb.

  These infants may be born alive, but would not live for more than hours or days after delivery. Physicians that are uncertain if they are caring for a pregnancy that involves a lethal anomaly will certainly have a second opinion from a perinatologist that concurs the baby would die in utero or shortly after birth, prior to ending the pregnancy.
- 8. The concern about mothers developing postpartum depression overlooks the reality of depressive conditions that occur after the mother has an abortion.
  Many women carry this "scar" with them for years.
- 9. Mothers, who aren't ready for a baby or another baby, would be able to give their baby up for adoption to a family that is ready and willing to raise that child.

10. Several physicians have discussed the medical conditions that occur when a woman is pregnant. These conditions occur in all pregnancies, not just the ones that were desired to be aborted.
